



# Tribal Case Study - Quapaw Nation


Aeroqual S500

# Considerations and Technical Challenges

- Equipment issues from harsh conditions
- Data loss from infrequent site visits
- High humidity can cause variation and drift
- Collocation of sensors before and after monitoring
